Intensive English Program provides high-quality instruction to students who need assistance acquiring academic English language skills for university study. Whether it's a semester or an academic year, the IEP works to help students attain academic, professional, and personal goals.

Conditional Undergraduate Admission is offered to student applicants that have met all requirements except English language proficiency. Once students successfully complete the IEP Bridge Program or submit a qualifying language score, they begin their undergraduate studies.

GLOBAL AMBASSADOR PROGRAM pairs an IEP student with a domestic student ready to welcome them to campus and act as a mentor throughout the semester.

EXCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES are offered throughout the term. A trip to Memphis & Graceland, movie nights in Oxford, trips to the local lakes, or a visit to Blues Country are often offered at no cost. Weekend excursions are offered during the breaks at an additional cost. Previous excursions have included Atlanta, Chicago, Las Vegas, Nashville, and New Orleans.

AIRPORT PICK UP AND DROP OFF is available at no charge for students flying to and from the Memphis International Airport on arrival and departure day.

HOUSING is available for IEP students to reside in an on-campus residential hall. Space is limited, so we ask that students reserve their room as soon as possible.
